Dear school community,

On Saturday, Maya, along with her family and Mrs Morrison attended an award ceremony at the Melbourne Exhibition and Convention Centre celebrating the achievements of all Victorian students. How exciting! Well done Maya.

On Wednesday 30th we held the final School Review Panel. Forums of teachers and students explored a variety of topics relating to school improvement. A report will be compiled by the reviewer and this will form the building blocks of our planning in 2017.

Thursday 1st of December is our Night of Democracy where our senior students demonstrate their understandings of the politics of the world around us.
