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From the Principal

Dear Ivanhoe Primary School Community,

Our School Vision is scaffolded by the values of confidence, independence, persistence, resilience and respect.

Resilience How do you help your child to calm down or manage their feelings when upset?
Here are some practical tips:

- firstly accept that it is normal and healthy for your child to experience negative emotions.
- provide your child with words to describe his/her own feelings as well as your own feelings (I see you are feeling..., I amthat you did....., what do you think we/you can do to make this better?).
- teach your child to say to themselves “calm down” and take three breaths before doing something he/she finds frightening or when he/she is angry or upset.
- discuss with your child the importance of finding an adult to talk to when he/she is feelings upset or down. This could be a family member or a teacher (or the principal)
- teach your child to think of all the positives when he or she gets upset or angry (especially when a friend or peer calls them a name.)
- explain that if they are excluded from a game by a group of people they can find something fun to do with others. (The situation is never too bad, that it cannot be resolved.)

An important thing to remember is to encourage communication without exacerbating the issue. Make an appointment to see the class teacher as there is often two sides to every story.

Wreaths will be placed in front of our home made cenotaph by the school captains and our special guest Anthony Carbines MP State member for Ivanhoe.

We invite all our families and friends to attend this commemoration. Students who have family permission are encouraged to wear the service medals of their relatives.

This service is a formal, sombre event to be held in silence. There will be speeches by School Captains who will be following standard practice and procedures of the R.S.L. and education policies.

The service will conclude with a minute’s silence and the playing of the Last Post.

Each class has created a moving display including pictures, diagrams and a wall of student made poppies. The Box Hill R.S.L. is also providing a display of memorabilia. Families are welcome to stay after the service to view the displays.

The gold coin donation will be used to partly fund the musicians and to give a generous donation to Legacy. We sincerely hope that you can join us for this important event.
