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From the Principal

Dear community,

It is timely that our School Review occur in a year in which the government has made a significant investment in education infrastructure, policy and reform. We have been able to capitalise on funding to improve our learning environment and the new Framework for Improving Student Outcomes is a key construct on which to build on our excellent curriculum.

"The Framework for Improving Student Outcomes uses the latest research on student learning and global bestpractice to assist schools to focus their efforts on key areas that are known to have the greatest impact on school improvement." (DE&T)

Over the year staff have held targeted professional discussions around school data and drawn evidence based conclusions around student achievement, Literacy, Numeracy, Student Engagement and Wellbeing as well as Student Voice. The Review asks the question to what extent is our school aligned with the Framework for Improving Student Outcomes (FISO)?

Day One of Panel discussions is next Tuesday (8th November) and involves many of our staff presenting data on achievements from the last three years as well as contributing to the planning for the next Strategic Plan. Department initiatives provide the framework to guide the development of our Strategic Plan and ultimately we aim to build on and develop: curriculum planning and assessment, building teacher practice, building leadership teams, empowering students and building school pride, setting expectations and promoting inclusion; and building communities.

Day Two (30th November) focuses on the future, leading to the identification of possible goals, targets and key improvement strategies for the next Strategic Plan. From here the head reviewer provides a report to the Principal who seeks advice on its accuracy from the School Council President as well as our challenge partners (Principals of Penders Grove PS and Ivanhoe East PS). In December the outcomes will be published to the school community and the Strategic Plan and Annual Implementation Plan will be developed.

Other news to be aware of.

The new building (not a part of the Capital Works program) is due to arrive shortly. This building is to meet the requirements of our growing enrollment. IPS does not currently advertise for enrollments however we continue to enrol families to whom we are the closest school. Having this space aids in keeping class sizes down where possible. It will be exciting to see how this learning space develops.

Attendance at Working Bees will become more and more important in order to make the new building fit within the current landscape. Parents are encouraged to investigate flexible ways in which they can contribute to the effectiveness of our schools facilities and programs.

The increase in enrollment will lead to a change to our staffing profile and some vacancies in our ranks. The process for hiring teaching staff is a lengthy one so we will begin this shortly to ensure our team is in place for the beginning of the 2017 school year.

A lot of work is going on behind the scenes to develop the new IPS Website and once launched will provide the community with a plethora of information and resources. COMPASS will replace Skoolbag App in 2017 and (although
