

Enrolment Information for Ivanhoe Primary School

Enrolment Dates and Requirements

We accept enrolments from the second week in Term 2 (27th April 2009 for 2010).

Enrolments must be accompanied by an Immunisation Certificate and details of birth (Birth Certificate or Passport).

For children who were born outside Australia the correct visa sub-class must apply before enrolment is accepted.

For those families who live within our catchment area, please supply proof of residence in the form of a utilities bill or rental agreement or similar.

Catchment Area

Ivanhoe Primary School has a specific catchment area and if you live within that area your child is automatically accepted at the school.

If you live outside the catchment area we still encourage you to enrol your child, but it is on the understanding that he or she will go on a waiting list. Being a government school we are here to service the local community first. We look at the enrolment situation towards the end of the year and ascertain whether or not we are able to take children from the waiting list. Each year is different as we do not know what the situation will be from year to year.

Fee Structure (2009)

We have a book list which is made up of three sections:

Section A is a list of text books and stationery items (\$106 - \$145, depending on the year level of your child).

Section B is a fee of either \$70 or \$75 for shared classroom requisites (essential items). In junior grades this includes \$5 for the Junior School Concert.

Section C is a Voluntary Contribution for special projects and is \$50.

We encourage the use of our preferred supplier, however you can supply items from your own sources. (Certain items that specifically apply to our school must be ordered through our supplier).
