Ordering Online – A message from the Canteen Committee

Thankyou to all parents who have registered for the online ordering of canteen lunches.

The benefits of having the online ordering system will greatly improve the efficiency of running the canteen.

Canteen Online came about in response to Canteen Committee requirements and Parents requests. The Canteen Committee trialled Canteen Online in 2014 with a group of canteen users.

A research survey was sent out to parents late last year.

Canteen Online was approved by The Finance Committee and School Council.

The Online ordering system has been commissioned because of the following;

- * The lack of volunteers assisting the canteen manager.
- * Increased student population has increased the number of orders.
- * The technology makes the canteen manager's job more efficient.
- * The system is in line with the technology other school canteens are utilising.
- * Easy correlation of orders and preparation of food
- * More time to prepare food
- * Greater Allergy alerts
- * Parent advanced ordering.
- * Over all better Canteen service.

The School acknowledges a small increase in cost to parents however will endeavour to keep pricing as low as possible.

BPAY ADVICE

HAS YOUR CHILD BEEN SUPPLIED WITH CLEAN CLOTHES?

If so, please launder and return to the school office as soon as possible. Clean clothing is in demand in this wet, muddy weather.

VISITORS TO THE SCHOOL

All visitors, including parents, must report to the school office to sign in. Parents, please do not go directly to your child's classroom.

SUPERVISION OF CHILDREN BEFORE SCHOOL

Increasingly, more children are being dropped off at school well before 8.45am—in some cases at 8am.

If your child is not booked into the Before School Care program you must not leave your child unattended in the school grounds. Parents are responsible for making suitable arrangements for their children prior to the yard duty teachers arriving at 8.45am.

YARD SUPERVISION

Supervision of students before and after school is provided at the following times: **8.45 am to 9.00 am** and **3.30 pm to 3.45 pm**.

Outside these times supervision and / or collection of students is the responsibility of parents / guardians. For the safety of students parent support for these times is sought.

Parents who need to drop their child at school before 8.45 am should consider using the Before School Care program.
